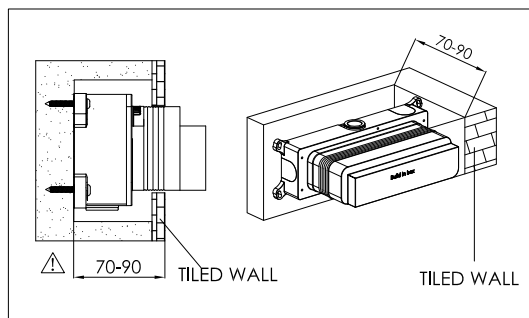


Coordinated Bathrooms Designed For You

Installation Steps

Diagram illustrating the rear view of the unit, showing the 'Build in box' and various connection points:

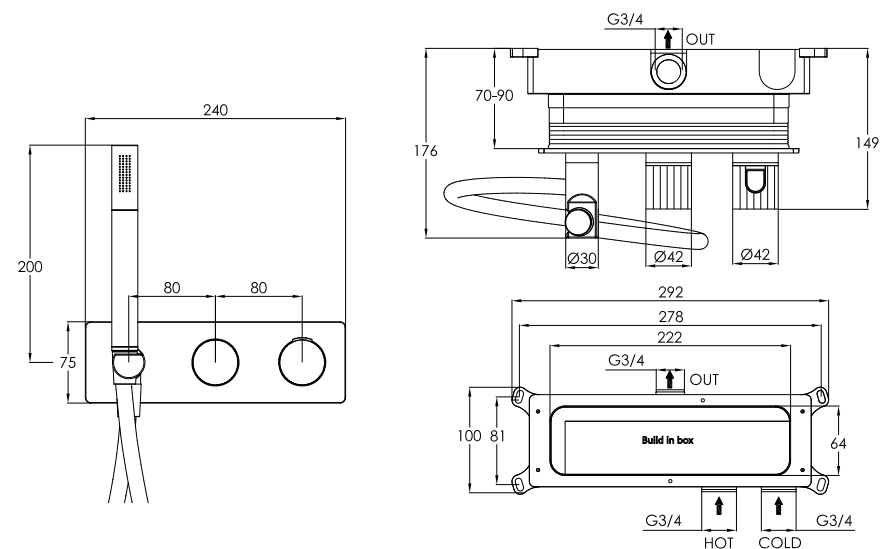
- OUT(BATH OR HEADSHOWER)**: Indicated by an upward arrow at the top center.
